The Project:

The Centre for Healthcare Quality and Innovation (CHQI), based at the Faculty of Health Sciences, University of Nairobi, seeks to recruit four (4) Software Developers on a three-month temporary basis in Nairobi, reporting to the Senior Systems Specialist.

Job Purpose:

Support front-end interfaces to backend systems, integrations, and data pipelines.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- a) Develop responsive frontends using React and other modern frontend frameworks;
- b) Build robust backends with Java, C# and Python, including RESTful APIs;
- c) Design and implement dashboards and reporting tools to support healthcare providers and other stakeholders;
- d) Develop and maintain ETL pipelines and contribute to data engineering tasks;
- e) Work with multiple databases (SQL and NoSQL) to support diverse solutions;
- f) Integrate with third-party services such as EMRs, bulk SMS providers, payment gateways, and other healthcare systems;
- g) Contribute to AI and machine learning initiatives (predictive analytics, automation, clinical insights);
- h) Deploy, monitor, and support solutions in production environments;
- i) Collaborate in a cross-functional team to design secure, scalable, and user-friendly systems.

- a) Bachelor's degree in Computer Science or a related field;
- b) Knowledge of React or any other frontend development framework;
- c) Expert-level competence in C#, Java or Python programming language;
- d) Familiarity with API design, development, and integration;
- e) Understanding of databases (relational and NoSQL). Basic experience in AI and machine learning concepts (NLP, predictive modelling, data science workflows).
